
#### Chairman's Corner



#### Site Picnic Directions to the Wausau transmission building.

- α. Basic highway directions
  - 1. I-39/Hwy 51 Exit 188
  - 11. From 29 E go North at Jct. with I-39/Hwy 51 to next exit #188
  - uu. From 10 E go North on I-39/Hwy 51 at Stevens Point approx.. 30 miles to exit 188
- b. Directions into the park (transmitter stations building is within the state park)
  - iv. Turn left at Exit 188 stop light
  - v. Go straight at next two stop lights (Rib Mt. State Park sign at 2<sup>nd</sup> light)
  - vi. After a few blocks, the road turns sharply left; turn Right on to Park Road at this point
  - vii. Proceed about 2 miles to the state park contact station
  - viii. Go about ¼ mile past the contact station to the transmission building driveway (at the fork in the road, one must turn right; the driveway is just around the corner on the left side, near the point where the observation deck parking lot entrance is on the right.

- II. Things to bring
  - c. Appetite! Most important.
  - d. Some are bringing folding chairs and/or card tables.
- III. Park Entry requirements
  - e. State Park entry fee normally required
  - f. All vehicles must stop at contact station
  - g. Park manager's offer to waive this fee for SBE guests
  - h. Mention arrival for broadcast engineers meeting to person at contact station
- IV. Transmission building tour(s)
  - i. Tours of the facility are planned
  - i. Public radio and TV facilities
  - k. Two commercial TV stations
  - I. Two commercial FM stations
  - m. Public safety communications


