Transport MMT is Topic of Module 4, SBE ATSC 3.0 Webinar Series

Dr. Young Lim of Samsung and Dr. Kyungmo Park of SK Telecom, will present a live webinar on Transport MMT at 2 p.m. EST, Wednesday, January 30. After successful development and deployment of media delivery standards such as MPEG-2 Transport Streams and ISO Base Media File Format, MPEG has developed new standards for IP-based services, namely MPEG Media Transport (MMT) and Dynamic Adaptive Streaming over HTTP (DASH). MMT has been developed for the industries enjoying the benefits of MPEG-2 TS but considering migration to IP-based delivery.



Japanese Super Hi-Vision was the first broadcasting service adopting MMT and then ATSC 3.0 also adopted it. In this webinar, important features of MMT utilizing benefits of IP, while preserving useful features of MPEG-2 TS and how they have been harmonized with ATSC 3.0 standards, will be presented.

U.S. Senate Passes READI Act

Just before the end of the year, the Senate passed the READI (Reliable Emergency Alert Distribution Improvement) Act, a bipartisan bill meant to improve the emergency alert system, extend it to new platforms and avoid a repeat of the false alarm nuclear missile strike alert in Hawaii that drew an FCC investigation.

While most of the points in the bill deal with the creation and origination of EAS alerts, one item is of interest to broadcasters, it would allow broadcasters to repeat presidential and FEMA alerts, something they can't do now.

The bill still must be passed by the House and approved by the president. After which, it will be sent to the FCC and FEMA to work out details of implementation, followed by FCC notice of rule changes. So, it will be some time before any changes to the way EAS Alerts are created and/or distributed.

The SBE will continue to issue updates as the bill moves through the approval process. Read the entire bill.



FCC to eliminate the requirement that TV and radio stations have to post the stations licenses on the transmitter control point

Adopted: December 10, 2018 Released: December 11, 2018 By the Commission:

1. In this Report and Order (Order), we eliminate the provisions in Parts 1, 5, 73 and 74 of our rules that require the posting and maintenance of broadcast licenses and related information in specific locations.1 In May 2018, the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (*NPRM*) seeking comment on whether to eliminate license posting rules that appeared to be redundant and obsolete now that licensing information is readily accessible online through the Commission's databases.2 Commenters in this proceeding unanimously support the elimination of these rules.3 As detailed below, we find that eliminating these requirements, which apply in some form to all broadcast licensees, will serve the public interest. In doing so, we advance the Commission's goal of modernizing our media rules and remove unnecessary regulatory burdens that impede competition and innovation in the media marketplace.4
