








URGENT UPDATE!

Certification News Congratulations to Mark Heller on getting his Television Operator license. With the digital conversion taking place, 2009 will see some changes in the certification technical material. The Certification Committee is working on a complete review and update of the of the multiple choice question pool to replace the current CertPreview. The Television Operators Certification Handbook 7th Edition was completed last November and was what Mark used to prepare for his test.

2008 was a good year for certification. 2009 looks like it could be just as well starting out with 89 exams scheduled for February, 2008 had 432 new certification, 284 recertifications and 82 applications waiting for approval at the council or national level. There were also 44 applications for Life Certification. If you have the opportunity to attend NAB this year, don't forget the SBE Membership Meeting on Tuesday April 21st at 1700 in the South Hall. 



April 20-24, 2009 - Wisconsin Tornado and Severe Weather Awareness Week Drill Day is Thursday April 23, 2009 from 1 to 2 PM.

The week of April 20-24, 2009 is Tornado & Severe Weather Awareness Week in Wisconsin. The Wisconsin Emergency Management team and the five National Weather Service Forecast Offices that service Wisconsin are asking that everyone take time to go over their safety plans so that they will be ready when severe weather strikes.

On Thursday, April 23th, a mock tornado drill will be conducted, with a mock tornado watch issued for all of Wisconsin and the adjacent coastal waters of Lake Michigan and Lake Superior at 1 P.M. On NOAA Weather Radio All Hazard this mock tornado watch will be broadcast as a Required Weekly Test (RWT). Additionally, on the NOAA Weather Wire, the test watch will appear in the product identifier of WCN (Watch County Notification) issued by each of the 5 NWS offices. Some of the newer weather radios will not receive the tone-activation for the RWT, however, you will hear the mock tornado watch message in the weather radio broadcast cycle if you turn your radio on. Between 1:10 and 1:55 P.M., each of the five NWS offices will issue mock tornado warnings. Likewise, the mock tornado warnings will be broadcast on NOAA Weather Radio All Hazards as a Required Weekly Test (RWT). Additionally, the test tornado warnings will be issued on the NOAA Weather Wire system by the 5 NWS offices in a test

TOR product identifier. Some of the newer weather radios will not receive the tone-activation for the RWT, however, you will hear the mock tornado warning message in the weather radio broadcast cycle if you turn your radio on.
